#### INDUSTRY OVERVIEW

In June, Purdue's Ag Barometer, an index tracking U.S. farmer sentiment on current and future economic conditions, dropped to its lowest level in almost three years, only to be followed by its largest one-month increase since its inception in July.

"The agricultural economy weakened considerably this spring" said James Mintert, the barometer's Principal Investigator and Director of Purdue University's Center for Commercial Agriculture. However, the coinciding relief that the difficult spring was finally over, coupled with the Federal Crop Insurance "Prevent Planting" program, were likely contributors to the dramatic sentiment turnaround.



Corn and wheat futures prices responded to lower anticipated supply by increasing approximately 25% and 15% respectively, by the end of June. Soybeans can be planted later in the season than corn which resulted in less dramatic planting delays, and markets were up only slightly over the last three months. Additional pressure to the soybean market is coming from China's 25% tariff on U.S. soybeans coupled with reduced demand by the Chinese pork industry as it battles to contain a major outbreak of African Swine Fever; a highly contagious disease with no cure or treatment other than containment by culling. An estimated 1.2 million hogs have been euthanized in China since the outbreak began.

Rapidly deteriorating diplomatic relations between Canada and China during the first half of 2019 have also pressured Canadian crop and livestock commodity markets, such as canola, pork and beef. In March, China halted all canola sales from Canada based on an unspecified "quality" issue, and in June, halted all beef and pork imports because it claimed the Canadian government inspection system had failed to detect the presence of a banned feed additive and inauthentic veterinary certificates. China represents 40% of Canada's canola export market and approximately 20% its pork exports.

SDR tracked 97 transactions involving businesses participating in and serving the Agribusiness Industry during the first half of 2019, with a median multiple of 2.1x revenue. This compares to 118 transactions, with a median multiple of 0.7x in the second half of 2018 and to 117 transactions, with a median multiple of 1.1x in the first half of 2018.

Machinery & Equipment, Crop/Turf/Ornamental Inputs, Aq Tech and Services, and Proteins were the most active M&A segments during the first six months of 2019.

The average EBITDA multiple for publicly traded Agribusiness companies was 14.1x LTM EBITDA by the end of the first half of 2019, up from 12.6x at the end of 2018, with the Ag Technologies and Services segment the highest at 18.9x and Crop, Turf and Ornamental Inputs, the lowest at 10.8x.

#### TRENDS TO WATCH

The sustained low income of farmers in U.S. over the last several years is starting to take a toll on farmers ability to cash flow their current debt. According to the Kansas City Fed, demand for farm loans remained high and the ability of farm borrowers to repay loans weakened at a slightly faster pace than in previous quarters. Bankers are continuing to restructure clients' debt with more collateral and the number of denied loan requests is increasing.

Most industry pundits feel that the \$16 billion in federal aid to help farmers weather the trade war, plus the \$19 billion for disaster aid will be woefully short to shore up balance sheets.

Another trend to watch is the ongoing public debate on the use of glyphosate in agriculture; the world's most widely used herbicide. Glyphosate has been instrumental in the widespread adoption of conservation practices such as no-till farming. The herbicide has been the subject of numerous scientific reviews and has been deemed safe when used as directed by 15 of the most credible government regulatory agencies in the world, including the European Food Safety Authority, the U.S. EPA, and Canada's PMRA. Despite such evidence, in 2015, The World Health Organization's International Agency for Research on Cancer classified the herbicide as a probable human carcinogen, triggering a series of lawsuits and a potential ban on its use across Europe.

Last year, a San Francisco landscaper successfully sued Bayer/Monsanto (one of the major manufacturers of the herbicide) and was awarded \$290 million as compensation (which was subsequently reduced to \$78.5 million) for his cancer that a jury concluded was caused by his years of exposure to the herbicide. In May, a couple was awarded \$2 billion in their lawsuit when a jury concluded that glyphosate had caused their Non-Hodgkin's lymphoma, however a judge will likely reduce that amount. There are approximately 13,000 more cases pending. Recently, class-action suits are being contemplated, accusing Monsanto of hiding evidence from regulators and regulator complacence.

Furthermore, some organizations such as the Centre for Environmental Health (CEH) and the Environmental Working Group (EWG) have conducted extensive testing of glyphosate residue levels in common foods like breakfast cereals. Many are testing positive, because of its widespread use in cereal crops, however at levels well below what credible scientific research would deem unacceptable or unsafe.

Either way, with activists employing the typical public scare tactics and a series of lawsuits, the future of the important herbicide looks bleak. Bayer bought Monsanto for \$63 billion before much of the public backlash and lawsuits had traction and is now actively exploring alternatives for the herbicide.

#### KEY TRANSACTIONS

Nutrien was an active buyer in the first half of 2019, completing acquisitions of specialty crop input manufacturer Actagro for \$320 million and Illinois-based Agri-retailer Van Horn. Actagro has been a supplier to Nutrien for many years and was a natural fit according to some industry observers. Van Horn's retail network of 11 locations was ranked as the 42nd largest in the U.S. and will be integrated with Nutrien's vast network of approximately 1,700 locations.

Wilbur-Ellis has also been active in the Agri-retail space, with the acquisition of California-based Ag Services and Nebraska-based Wiles Bros. in the first half of 2019.

In April, Campbell's announced the sale of Bolthouse Farms and Danone announced the sale of Earthbound Farms. You can read our blog article outlining our perspective on the transaction here.





Consolidation in the Ag Equipment Dealer space continued at a rapid pace through the first half of 2019, with numerous deals announced.

JBT Corp. has continued its consolidation strategy in the food processing equipment market, with the acquisition of poultry processing equipment manufacturer, Prime Equipment Group, for \$65 million, at an estimated 1.4x revenue, and UK-based packaging technology manufacturer, Proseal for £220 million.


Manitoba-based pork producer and processor Hylife announced it planned to sell 50.1% of its shares to Thailand's Charoen Pokphand Foods, for \$372 million, with the remaining 49.9% being retained by Japanese-based Itochu. The deal is expected to expand the pork processor's business in Asia.


#### TRANSACTIONS BY SEGMENT




